The schedule change for the Clothing Pantry kicked off in March. The Clothing Pantry is now open on Tuesdays from 12:00 to 1:30 and from 5:00 to 7:00.Thank you to the extra band of volunteers who are helping with the additional hours of this vital mission to our community.

The Congregational Life Committee is still planning to offer a monthly Community Meal at the church. The plan is to host this meal on the second Wednesday of the month. This committee is targeting April 10th as the first gathering. Please stay tuned as there will be more information to follow as we try to provide a great time for fellowship with friends and the opportunity to meet new folks who may be looking for a church home.

A big change will be occurring this summer with our worship times. The Council and Pastor Stephen discussed options and it was decided to have one service during the summer months that will be at 9 o'clock on Sunday mornings from June 2nd to September 1st. There will also be Sunday School happening during this time. Our Sunday School kids will start in church and then depart for their Sunday School lesson following the Children's Time. They will return for communion. Our normal two services will resume on September 8th.

A couple additional items to remember for your calendars. Our Meal and Mingle will occur on Sunday, April 21st and it will be held at the Urban Farmhouse in Highland. Please sign up in the Gathering Space so we know how many will be joining the group. Also, much planning and work is already underway for the city wide yard sale in which the church will be participating on Saturday, April 27th. Think about volunteering to help. Lastly, we will once again work on some spring cleaning opportunities. Be on the lookout for more information on this as we work to keep our church and outside grounds looking great!


